

PORTABLE DOG FENCE INSTALLATION

Using PVC Coated Steel Panels



THINGS YOU'LL NEED

- [Portable Metal Dog Fence Kit](#)
- (Optional) Hammer

USE ON GRASS / SOIL

Step 1: Place your panels in the shape you'd like the temporary enclosure to have.

Place a panel connector and metal fence pin in between the panels for easy access.



Step 2: Connect two panels by twisting the panel connector down at the joints.



Step 3: Connect all joints using the same technique.

Tip: At this stage, you can fold up the panels and readjust the position of your temporary enclosure.



Step 4: Push a fence pin into the middle of a panel connector.



Step 5: Once it's in its final location, hammer the fence pin into the ground for added stability.

Note: if the soil is soft enough, you may be able to push the pins into the ground by hand as well.



Step 6: Hammer/push in the rest of your fence pins as you go along.



Step 7: For the door of the enclosure, you will need a joint with a panel connector on each side.



Step 8: To easily open and close the door, you should have a fence pin in both panel connectors, one pushed into the ground at all times and the other one pulled out just enough to allow for movement.



Step 9: Place your dog inside the enclosure and let them enjoy the outdoors safely. 😊

USE ON CONCRETE / PAVEMENT



For concrete or pavement, you will not be able to make use of the fence pins.

The enclosure should still be freestanding and fairly sturdy with just the helicals connecting the panels together.
