

DIY FRAME WITH CHICKEN WIRE FOR PICTURES

Step by Step Guide

What You'll Need:

- Chicken Wire
- Packing Tape
- Frame
- Paint
- Staple Gun
- Wire Cutters
- Sandpaper
- Pliers

Step 1



Measure the inner size of the frame with a tape measure. Make sure that you get enough mesh to cover the measured size.

Step 2



Remove everything from the frame (glass or backing for example). Slightly sand it so it is ready for painting.

Step 3



Paint the wood by hand or spray paint and let it dry. If you would like, you can give it a second coat of paint, then let dry again.

Step 4



If you want to give it an aged look, you can distress it – sand it again to take some of the paint off.

Step 5



Cut out a slightly bigger piece of the chicken wire than the size of the frame you previously measured. Use gloves and a wire cutter for the job.

Step 6



Start by securing one side of the mesh to the frame. Staple along the side from top to bottom at every second hole.

Step 7



Once the side is done, attach the mesh along the top. By attaching in an L shape, you will be able to pull on the mesh to straighten it.

Step 8



Pull on the mesh while attaching the remaining parts to make it taut. This will give enough strength to the wire to hold the photos.

Step 9



Cover the ends of the chicken wire with packing or sealing tape so they don't poke out and damage anything.

Step 10



Now that you are all done, you can hang your jewelry on this finished DIY project.
