DIY Flower Arrangements With Chicken Wire

STEP BY STEP GUIDE

What You'll Need:

- Pliers
- Wire Cutters
- Chicken Wire


- Vase
- Measuring Tape
- Flowers



Place the vase on the chicken wire. This is going to be the width that you will need to cut.



Measure the height of the vase. The length of the wire that you need to cut is going to be the height times two.



Based on the previous measurements, cut the wire to size. Make sure to wear a pair of protective gloves to avoid injuries and use wire cutters.



Fold the mesh inside the vase, but do not crumple it up. Bring the ends close together in a downwards movement. Once you have a ball-like cushion, push in the bottom so the stems can go through both layers of wire.



Fill the vase halfway through with water if you are planning to use real flowers. If you are using fake flowers, you can leave it empty.



Decide on what kinds of flowers you would like for the arrangement, select them and cut them to fit the vase. Don't forget to add some greenery as well to give it a fuller look.



Always start with the greenery to conceal the wire. After that you can use the blooms to create a nice arrangement.



If the mesh is nice and secure, fill the vase up with water and get the flowers ready. At this point you can follow a floral recipe or just simply arrange the flowers to your liking.
