Additional: Bury Mesh

Dig a trench along the fence line, approximately 15-30 cm deep.

wire into the trench.

Place the bottom edge of the chicken

Backfill the trench with soil, pressing it down tightly to hold the wire in place and stop animals from burrowing under it.
